## VIRGIN ACTIVE AUSTRALIA NSW GOVERNMENT ACTIVE KIDS VOUCHER RULES



- 1. A copy of the NSW Office of Sport Active Kids voucher must be provided by any member or new Swimsters member wishing to redeem it against swim fees.
- 2. An Active Kids voucher can only be utilized for full term fees; they can not be utilized for a partial term enrolment.
- 3. Active Kids vouchers cannot be split up over terms.
- 4. Only one voucher per child may be redeemed per annum.
- For current members, the voucher will need to be provided at least 7 days before the next direct debit. That is Monday the week before the direct debit.
- 6. New members can only use the voucher for full term fees and the voucher must be presented on sign up.
- In the event that Virgin Active can't redeem the voucher via the NSW Government scheme the person who has used the voucher must pay \$100 difference the next club fortnightly direct debit. Virgin Active will then liaise with the voucher bearer to remediate the redemption issue.
- 8. It is up to the owner of the voucher to ensure that the voucher is valid. Virgin Active takes no responsibility for invalid vouchers.
- 9. Active Kids vouchers are non-refundable, non-transferable and Virgin Active takes no responsibility for lost vouchers.
